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Advancing research, development, and access of new diagnostic and medicines for neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) is limited by fragmented demand and complicated procurement & supply logistics, among other reasons. One solution to overcome this challenge is to harmonize supply chains and shape market dynamics across vendors and buyers through pooled procurement pathways for newly developed health technologies.

Global Institute for Disease Elimination (GLIDE) and Uniting Efforts for Innovation, Access and Delivery are co-hosting a roundtable discussion on the requirements for developing such pooled procurement mechanisms for NTDs.
